On Monday, 11/30/20, Seymour Community School Corporation will transition to a virtual instructional model. This means that students, grades KG-12, will work remotely. Our hope is to have students back for in-person instruction as soon as possible.

We are experiencing extreme staff shortages due to contact tracing and quarantining. Our operational situation will be evaluated on a weekly basis and a decision on whether we can return to our current hybrid (grades 6-12) and in-person/virtual model (grades KG-5) for the week of 12/7/20 will be announced on Thursday, 12/3/20, if not before.

Like schools and universities around our state and nation who have moved to all virtual instruction, we realize that this is not a convenient situation for many of our families. However, the safety of our students and staff is paramount and remains our priority.

Further details will come from your child's specific school. In the meantime, we urge all of our families to follow established health protocol in order to help our community heal and rebound from the COVID-19 pandemic.
