Next Monday, February 22, 2021, Seymour Community Schools will be moving off of the hybrid instructional model and back to in-person instruction for grades 6-12. This change will not impact SCSC elementary schools, grades KG-5, which have remained open to in-person instruction the entire time.

Last week, the Indiana State Department of Health released new guidance for Indiana schools. Based on the new guidance, latest data, and approval by local health professionals, we can safely make this change. Masks will be required in class at all times. This will allow social distancing to be reduced to 3 feet when needed, but will also reduce, and in some cases completely eliminate, the quarantining of asymptomatic students and staff. As always, we will continue to monitor state, local, and internal conditions. Any changes will be communicated with you as soon as possible.
