COMMUNICATIONS & REPORTS

SUPERINTENDENT COMMENTS

Mr. Harpe gave the 2017 summer school update.

Mrs. Altemeyer presented information on offering a Certificate of Multilingual Proficiency.

Mr. Fosbrink shared the changes in state law regarding the transportation of preschool students.

Mr. Stark gave the facilities and grounds project update.

Mr. Prange presented the new 2017-2018 student drop-off and pick-up procedures.

AUDIENCE COMMENTS

Mr. Prange reported that graduation rates may change dramatically due to changes at the federal level. The general high school diploma will no longer be recognized. 20% of the Class of 2017 received the general diploma.

Mrs. Jennifer Miller, spoke on behalf of the SMS and SHS Tennis programs as well as the feeder programs. She said they use all 10 courts for both fall and spring seasons. Mrs. Miller said we once held Regionals here, but they have since moved due to us not having quality courts. The tennis boosters would like to bring the Regionals back to Seymour.

BOARD COMMENTS

Mr. Joray wished Mrs. Hernandez a happy birthday.

Mrs. Franke said she visited RoBoCode camp and the Preschool program at Brown. She was also able to attend a day of the FFA State Convention.

Mr. Juergens said the new main entrance at the high school looks great.

ACTION ITEMS

Mr. Stark presented estimates and options for the SHS Tennis Court repairs. Mr. Silver motioned to hire Pro Track & Tennis Inc out of Nebraska to fix the 4 courts in most need of major repairs for \$69,469 with the understanding that we will not pay any money up front. Mr. Kelley seconded. After discussion, the Board gave permission for Mr. Nauman to pay as the project progressed. Motion carried; 7-0.

Mr. Stark made a recommendation to accept and award the quote for the SMS roof repair to Royalty Roofing for \$39,732.73. Mr. Browning motioned to approve the repair and Mr. Kelley seconded. Motion carried; 7-0.

Mr. Stark made a recommendation to approve the \$8,850 quote from Kenny Glass to install an ADA door at Seymour Middle School. Mr. Klosterman moved and Mr. Browning seconded. Motion carried; 7-0.

Mr. Fosbrink made a recommendation to approve the 2017-2018 Bus Driver Handbook. The only changes were the addition of CPR requirement and preschool transportation regulations. Mr. Joray motioned to approve the handbook and Mrs. Franke seconded. Motion carried; 7-0.

Mrs. Altemeyer made a recommendation to:

Accept the additional Title 1 allocation of \$17,094.86,

Accept the 2017 Safe Haven grant of \$20,000,

Apply for the 2017 Title IIA Grant - (Anticipated \$129,430.63)

Apply for the 2017-2019 Title III Grant - (Anticipated \$121,308.25)

Apply for the 2017-2018 NESP Grant - (Anticipated \$232,156.00)

Mr. Silver moved and Mrs. Franke seconded. Motion carried; 7-0.

Mrs. DuBois made a recommendation to apply for the Harbor Freight Tools for Schools grant to be used for technology and agriculture programs. Mr. Klosterman moved and Mr. Browning seconded. Motion carried; 7-0.

Mrs. Wessel made a recommendation to modify the Seymour Middle School grading scale to be consistent with the rest of the school corporation. Mrs. Franke motioned to approve and Mr. Kelley seconded. Motion carried; 7-0.

Mr. Nauman made a recommendation to approve the 2017-2018 Seymour High School textbook rental prices. Mr. Joray motioned to approve and Mr. Silver seconded. Motion carried; 7-0.

Mr. Hooker made a recommendation to approve the one year agreement with Child Care Network for before and after school childcare and a three year agreement with the Foster Grandparent program. Mr. Klosterman moved and Mr. Silver seconded. Motion carried; 7-0.

NEW BUSINESS - FIRST READ ITEMS

Mr. Stark recommended we have a public auction this fall. He will send out the specifications to local auctioneers.

Mr. Hooker discussed background check procedures and teacher appreciation grants. He added both will be topics of discussion during negotiations this year.

Mr. Nauman discussed the 2018 budget. He said they will need to look at doing another bond issue before the end of the year to maintain the current tax rate.
