SCSC Preschool Opportunity

Seymour Community Schools is currently seeking preschoolers for our peer model preschool program at Jackson Elementary School for the 2025-2026 School Year. This program is designed to integrate typically developing peers with children who have identified educational needs. All children engage in a variety of activities and functional routines to help them build self-regulation, social-emotional, and academic skills that prepare them for their transition to kindergarten.

The overall goals of this program are to:

- Provide a diverse classroom environment in which students of all abilities learn together.
- Provide the opportunity for children with differing abilities to interact, learn to play cooperatively, participate in functional routines, and build pre-academic skills through exposure to developmentally appropriate activities
- Allow children to develop individual learning styles and to learn at their own rate
- Provide developmentally appropriate models to children with developmental delays
- Provide the opportunity to develop compassion and understanding of the diversity within the community

Requirements:

- Children must be between 3-5 years old. Priority is given to children between 4-5 years old and the order in which applications are received.
- Families must provide transportation for the child to and from school.
- All candidates will go through a screening process to ensure that the Jackson peer model program is an appropriate fit.

Additional Information:

- There is no cost to attend this program.
- The preschool class runs Tuesday-Friday for 3 hour sessions. We will have a morning class (8:45 - 11:30) or afternoon class (12:15 - 3:00) option.
